Aim:

The Young Engineers Western Australia group is running the Engineers Ambassadors Program (EAP). This program is aimed at educating and inspiring Year 10 high school students about the engineering profession and to ensure that they pick the prerequisite subjects in upper school to get into uni. This program is vital to ensure that we help the students to become tomorrow's engineers.

General Information:

The program specifically targets Year 10 students, to help them to select the appropriate upper school subjects for the study of engineering at university. The talks are also available to upper school students if the school is interested.

The talk will be a multimedia presentation delivered by two young engineers and will take approximately half an hour. It will cover the basics of what an engineer does, the different types of engineering, and what you studying at university. The speakers will then talk more specifically about their personal experiences of studying and for working as an engineer. The students will be invited to ask questions, and will be left with a handout summarising the key aspects of engineering.

These presentations will be held from the 23rd March 2005, on school days between 10am and 3pm. Most of the talks occur in first semester, however they will be required in second semester.

Invitations will be sent to most secondary schools in the Perth metropolitan area and we wish to accommodate as many schools that wish to participate in the program.
