
New Feature: Track Edit MERGE Command (Manual page 135)


A MERGE track edit command has been added to enhance the unit's audio playback performance.

MERGE

Audio playback performance can be improved by using this command to merge a number of separate regions (sections of audio data created in separate recording passes) in a specified track into one continuous region.

The merge command creates a continuous region from the beginning of the track to the end of the last region on the track, and sections of the track that contained no regions are replaced with audio silence.





Parameter list -

Parameter	Range	Explanation
1 From TR	1–16	A single audio track
	1/2-15/16	A pair of adjacent odd-numbered/ even-numbered audio tracks
2 From V.TR	1–8	Virtual track number

Troubleshooting (Manual page 203)

- A small amount of noise is produced when a song is played back on a different AW1600 unit
- A small amount of noise may be heard at the beginnings and ends of audio regions when a song created on an AW1600 unit with Version 1.1 firmware is played back on an AW1600 with Version 1.0 firmware.
